

Call for Applications „Dr. Gustav Winkler Scholarship“ for Israeli Students

Deadline: December 15

Purpose

At least three language training scholarships will be awarded next year for Israeli university/college students (Bachelor and Master) majoring in technology or any other field. The language course will be offered by a German language provider in Berlin.

Funding has been donated by Dr. Gustav Winkler in appreciation of the fifty-year anniversary of German-Israeli relations in order to provide young students with an opportunity to learn German, to get to know the culture and to specifically establish initial contacts with Germans in their field of study.

Duration

One month, usually between June and November, at least 18 teaching days with at least 25 teaching hours per week.

Coverage

The scholarship covers the language course fee as well as living expenses (in total 1061 € flat, regardless of the chosen language course and/or place of study) and a flat charge to cover travel expenses. Furthermore, it will be taken care of an insurance coverage (casualty, health, liability).

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must be at least 18 years of age and they have to be enrolled in an Israeli university or college (Michlala). German language skills should be at least A1 and no more than B1.3 based on the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages.

Application Process

Selection

A selection committee reviews the applications. Key criteria are the academic achievements to date and a convincing motivation with regard to the language course.
