

Call for Applications „Dr. Gustav Winkler Scholarship“ for Israeli College (Michlala) Students

Deadline: December 1 of each year

Purpose

At least two intensive language training scholarships will be awarded next year for Israeli college (Michlala) students majoring in technology or any other field. The language course will be offered by a German language institute within the Federal Republic of Germany.

Funding has been donated by Dr. Gustav Winkler in appreciation of the fifty-year anniversary of German-Israeli relations in order to provide young students with an opportunity to learn German, to get to know the culture and to specifically establish initial contacts with Germans in their field of study.

Duration

Two months between June and December.

Coverage

The scholarship covers the language course fee as well as living expenses (in total 2,300 € flat, regardless of the chosen place of study) and a flat charge to cover travel expenses. Furthermore, it will be taken care of an insurance coverage (casualty, health, liability).

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must be at least 18 years of age and they have to be enrolled in an Israeli college (Michlala). German language skills should be at least A1 and no more than B1 based on the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages.

Application Process
