I am a Masters' student in the Master of Education, Department of Educational science and Management, School of Education.

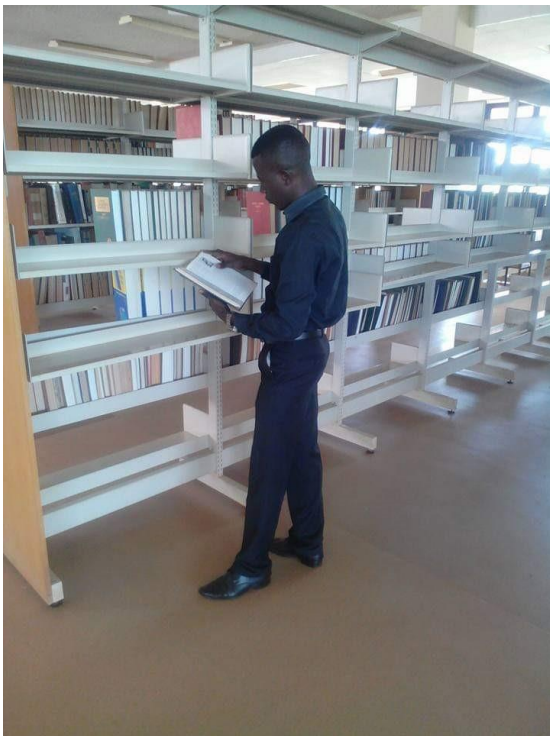
